A message from your Regional Trustee



Once again we are starting a new year with an air of uncertainty still hanging over us. Whilst the Omicron variant seems to be less debilitating than Delta, the fact that it is more transmittable will do nothing to restore the social confidence of members who remain wary after almost two years of

various legal and social restrictions.

However, the movement includes members with a broad range of attitudes, and many who are fully vaccinated are already once again taking the opportunity to get out and about and organising meetings and face to face activities. In England we've not had many of the same legal restrictions as Wales and Scotland, and the responsibility is therefore often on individuals to decide how they want to behave. Those members who do want to see a return to "normality" as soon as possible will have an enormous role to play as u3as try to restore activities and encourage others to emerge from the last two years. However, equally I hope that these members recognise that for some people, social confidence is often difficult to regain, and the pace of recovery will clearly be a matter of personal choice for many members.

Elsewhere, the u3a Board has been taking the opportunity to re-evaluate the structure of the movement and the way that it operates. This includes almost every aspect of the way support and advice is provided to u3as, as well as the coordination and encouragement of learning, and showcasing/communicating the achievements of u3as. With over a 1,000 u3as in the UK, and over 400,000 u3a members, the movement grew significantly prior to the pandemic and the support arrangements for members needs to catch up with the rapid social and technological changes that have also taken place. So look out for gradual improvements throughout this year.

The Anniversary Quilt competition has been judged and 40 squares on the topic of Positive Ageing have been selected for the quilt which we hope will be revealed on as part of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee weekend. Enquiries to U3a Office

Ever wondered why some of your enquiries to the office go unanswered? During a recent review of resource requirements in the u3a office, the Advice and Volunteering section clocked an average of over **1000** telephone calls per month and between **800-900** emails per month to the generic u3a.office email address. This workload is currently shared between 4 full time equivalent staff, some of whom work part time together with a small group of volunteers.

The review will hopefully lead to an improvement in resources and better access to advice and FAQs via the website, with better clarification when general communications like the newsletters are issued. Whilst the u3a movement is a member organisation and contact with members will always be part of the service, members are asked to think twice before contacting the office. Perhaps their query can be answered in a different way.

u3a Growing the Future

To mark the u3a movement's 40th Anniversary in 2022, the Trust is creating a u3a anniversary woodland situated in the Brecon Beacons.

u3a member's contribution to the u3a woodland will help benefit the environment, wildlife and climate for future generations.

The movement's target was for 5,000 trees to be planted between October 2021 and March 2022 and the good new is that over 6000 are now on their way to being planted. We are now setting a new target of 10,000.

u3a members are able to buy individual trees or a copse of 100 trees and u3as are also encouraged plant trees within their own communities.

Since its inception in early 2020, Trust u3a has proved to be an invaluable forum for providing learning opportunities to members. Whilst the original intention had been to create Tu3a for a limited 12 month period, the continuation of Covid restrictions and the undoubted popularity of group-based online activities has justified its continuation. Membership has been steadily increasing and now stands at over 1,000 members, all enjoying access to over 80 online interest groups. However, this success and popularity has created a number of challenges.

As Tu3a was originally set up on a temporary basis and largely administered by volunteers with support from u3a office staff, this makes it difficult to justify an independent u3a status. In addition, the increasing appetite for the concept of online interest groups suggests that Tu3a activities should be properly supported as a key part of the Trust's learning activities. Online interest groups are becoming increasingly more popular throughout the UK, and demand is increasing throughout the entire u3a membership.

Consequently, the Board has decided that effective from April 2022, Tu3a will become a part of the Trust's overall learning provision and Tu3a administration will be fully supported by u3a office staff. This does not mean that any of the current online groups will change, and we expect all current Tu3a group-based activities to continue unchanged with volunteers leading online interest groups.

The effect of this change is that Tu3a will become a key part of the Trust's Online Learning Platform and the change will enable Tu3a activities to be managed alongside the National Learning Programme, the Shared Learning Programme and the activities of Subject Advisers.

Arrangements for membership after April 2022 are currently being developed and all members will be contacted as soon as possible.
